

On Tuesday, November 6, 2018, Asotin residents will have the opportunity to provide funding for basic technology replacement and facility repairs for the next two years.

Background Information

- The State of Washington changed the process in which schools are funded.
- The expiring M&O Levy (now called the Enrichment Levy) is \$4.28/\$1000 of assessed value.
- The last payment on the current M&O levy is October 2018.
- Our Enrichment Levy, which will begin in April 2019, was reduced to \$1.50/\$1000 due to the cap that the State placed on all school districts. This took away the ability for local communities to support schools as they have in the past.
- Schools across the state are finding that they will be required to drastically reduce staff and programs over the next four years.
- Below is how Asotin-Anatone School District has been affected:

\$1.895	State Tax Part 1-Everyone pays
\$1.030	State Tax Part 2-Seniors/Disabled can apply for exemption
\$2.925	Total State School Tax for 2018
\$4.280	Asotin Schools adjusted amount
\$7.205	Total taxpayers are currently paying for Asotin Schools in 2018

Year 2019	**Assuming the State portions remain the same
\$1.895	State Tax Part 1-Everyone pays
\$1.030	State Tax Part 2-Seniors/Disabled can apply for exemption
\$2.925	Total State School Tax for 2019
\$1.500	Asotin Schools adjusted amount. (Previously 4.28/\$1000)
\$0.800	Asotin Schools proposed Capital Levy for basic technology replacement and facility needs for next two years
\$5.225	Estimated amount taxpayers will pay in 2019

If our proposed Capital Levy passes, your estimated school tax for the Asotin-Anatone School District will be **reduced** by \$1.98/\$1000 assessed value. By Resolution, the Capital Levy funds can only be used for basic technology and facility repairs.



The requested two year Capital Levy of \$.80/\$1000 of assessed valuation will fund the basic technology and facility needs for the next two years. Other reductions will be necessary in order to bridge the gap between state funding and local levies. See our website for our 4-year plan.
