

**SECTION 8:
OCCUPATIONAL INJURY AND ILLNESS RECORDKEEPING**

All employers covered by the Washington Industrial Safety and Health Act (WISHA) are covered by Chapter 296-27 WAC -Recordkeeping and Reporting. The purpose of this standard is to require employers to record and report work-related fatalities, injuries, and illnesses.

Note: Recording or reporting a work-related injury, illness or fatality does not mean that the employer or employee was at fault, that a rule has been violated, or that the employee is eligible for workers' compensation or other benefits.

All Incident Report forms and SIF-2 forms will be maintained at the ESD 112 Workers' Compensation Claims Department in Vancouver.

Note: WAC 296-27-00105 (1)(b) exempts school districts from certain injury and illness recordkeeping requirements. Thus, the Asotin-Anatone School District is not required to post the Annual Summary of Occupational Injury and Illness (OSHA Form 300 A). However information contained on the OSHA 300 logs is available from the SE Washington Workers' Compensation Trust when required by WISHA, OSHA or the Bureau of Labor Statistics.
