

Asotin-Anatone Education Foundation Scholarship Application 2021

Dear Applicant:

The Asotin-Anatone Education Foundation (AAEF) will award Seven Scholarships to seven Asotin High School graduating seniors of the Class of 2021. These Scholarships are available for any post secondary education, including vocational or trade schools. Scholarships given will be a one-time award.

Five of these seven scholarships will be the AAEF Scholarships, to include: One Scholarship Award in the amount of \$1000.00, and four Scholarships in the amount of \$500.00 each. The final two scholarships will be the Holly Heistuman Memorial Scholarships, which will be in the amount of \$1000.00 each.

Recipients of these seven Scholarship Awards will be determined by the AAEF Scholarship Committee, and announced by the Asotin-Anatone Education Foundation, in close proximity to graduation day.

The application will consist of three parts: (1) Applicant Information; (2) Letter of Recommendation from an Asotin High School teacher: and, (3) the Applicant's essay.

All three parts must be completed in its entirety, and submitted to the **Counselor at Asotin High School** by: **Monday, April 12, 2021**. Be sure to satisfy and complete each of the three application parts, and express your responses and comments in the order as indicated on the application form. Failure to do so will result in your application being determined incomplete, and will not be considered further.

You will need additional space to complete this application in its entirety. To accomplish this, please use additional paper, or complete the entire application on separate paper.

Every Scholarship awarded must be used by February 15th of the following year, at your designated Educational Institution.
