

The purpose of the Education Grants is to make money available, through a grant application, to benefit the students and staff of the Asotin-Anatone School District.

Eligibility: Any person or group is welcome to submit an application for a project that benefits the Asotin-Anatone public schools.

Objectives: All proposed projects should support the Asotin-Anatone District’s Strategic Plan.

Restrictions: Capital improvements and playground equipment are not eligible for Grants. Applications for out-of-town travel are discouraged.

Applications: Applications may be obtained from the Asotin Elementary, Middle School or High School office. Submit applications to the building principal.

Application Deadline: Applications must be received by the building principal by a deadline specified by the Education Grant Committee. This deadline is typically in October.
